

Welcome to Level 2 Massage Professional (Head Massage) at Wirral Met. This course will introduce you to the advanced techniques, skills and knowledge required to deliver head massage treatments.

## **COURSE DETAILS**

This course is designed to provide you with the practical and theoretical skills to deliver head massage at an occupational level. During your time with us, you will cover a range of topics including: - Massage Techniques- Use of products such as oils- Contraindications and risks for head massage - Physiology of head massage - Client consultation

## **ENTRY GUIDELINES**

To study a Level 2 qualification, you will need:

A minimum of 4 GCSEs at grade 3, including English and Maths (or L1 Functional Skills in English and Maths)

OR

A relevant Level 1 qualification with GCSE English and Maths at grade 3 or above (or L1 Functional Skills in English and Maths)

Satisfactory interview and/or assessment
